



Auto Crop Example

After capturing a photograph, Instant ID as a Service detects the Applicant's face then crops the photograph to include the Applicant's face and some of the surrounding area. The Crop Area value sets amount of surrounding area included in the photograph.

For example, a value of 0 includes only the Applicant's face. A value of 100 includes the Applicant's face and some of the surrounding area including the Applicant's hair.

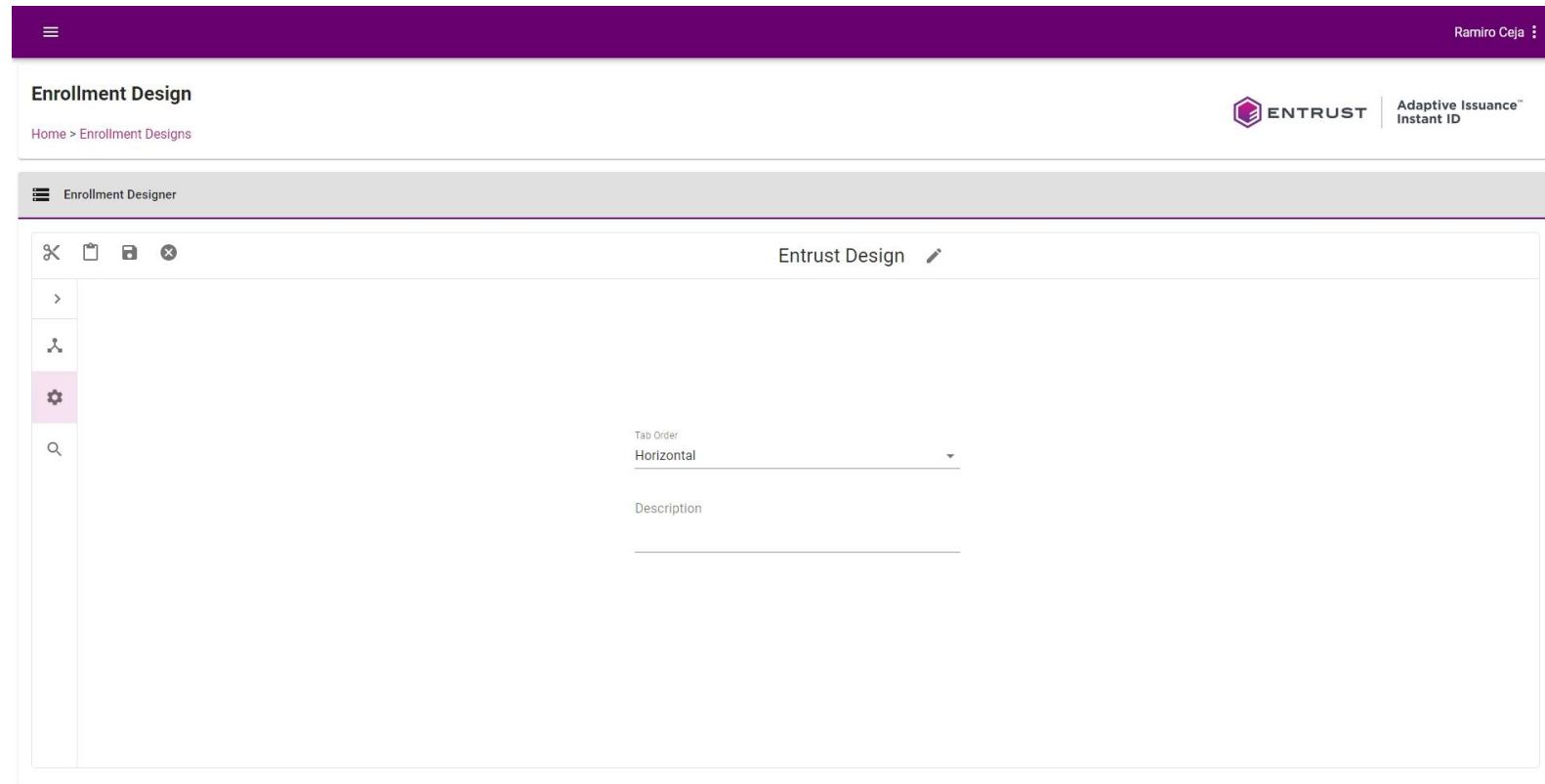


